Atlanta, GA - For Release –October 4, 2017 – The Georgia Interscholastic Cycling League (GA League) will host its 3rd mountain biking race of the season for middle and high school athletes this Sunday, October 8th at the Georgia International Horse Park, located at 1996 Centennial Olympic Parkway Conyers GA 30013. The Middle School Boys will roll out for the first start of the day at 8:30am, with the Varsity High School Girls kicking off the girl's races at 9:45am. The freshman will get the boys started at 11:45am, with the Varsity boys starting at 1:15pm. Forty-seven teams and 400+ student-athletes from across Georgia and parts of South Carolina are expected to compete in the race. View a map of all teams [HERE](#).
